Why It Matters

Watch how the Abraham Accords plays a leading role toward a one-world religion.

The Abraham Accords calls for something never done in previous accords pursuing peace. It includes religious tolerance between Jews, Christians, and Muslims—each one claiming Abraham as the father of its faith.

While Christians are tolerant of people of other religions, not imposing our faith on anyone, we should never worship together with anyone who does not worship God through Jesus Christ.

And while the Abraham Accords does not call for joint worship, it sets up a kind of interfaith ecumenism, an introduction to what will become joint worship. That is exactly what the Harlot religion of Revelation 17 looks like!

As of today, The Abraham Accords signers are Israel, the United Arab Emirates, Bahrain, Morocco, and Sudan — with Sudan suspended since

We, the undersigned, recognize the importance of maintaining and strengthening peace in the Middle East and around the world based on mutual understanding and coexistence, as well as respect for human dignity and freedom, including religious freedom.



We encourage efforts to promote interfaith and intercultural dialogue to advance a culture of peace among the three Abrahamic religions and all humanity.

We believe that the best way to address challenges is through cooperation and dialogue and that developing friendly relations among States advances the interests of lasting peace in the Middle East and around the world.

We seek tolerance and respect for every person in order to make this world a place where all can enjoy a life of dignity and hope, no matter their race, faith or ethnicity.

We support science, art, medicine, and commerce to inspire humankind, maximize human potential and bring nations closer together.

We seek to end radicalization and conflict to provide all children a better future.

We pursue a vision of peace, security, and prosperity in the Middle East and around the world.

In this spirit, we warmly welcome and are encouraged by the progress already made in establishing diplomatic relations between Israel and its neighbors in the region under the principles of the Abraham Accords.

We are encouraged by the ongoing efforts to consolidate and expand such friendly relations based on shared interests and a shared commitment to a better future.

We may see another treaty produce a moment of respite from war with Iran before Daniel’s “covenant with many,” but there would be no need for that covenant if any other one succeeded. Thus, all others are doomed to fail.

their government is gone. Kazakhstan, Somaliland, and Kosovo have all agreed to an expanded framework.

Watch how these frameworks build political, economic, and religious cooperation, even as open hostility toward Israel continues in other parts of the region.

This is what the Apostle John tells us to watch for in Revelation 13.

- “authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation” (vs. 7).
- “no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast, or the number of his name” (vs. 17).
- “All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb” (vs. 8).

Watch the way these accords help fuel a sense of “peace and security” for Israel that God warns will turn to sudden destruction under the coming An-

tichrist (Ezek. 13:10-16; I Thess. 5:3; Dan. 7:7-8, 24-25; 9:27; Matt. 24:15-22).

Watch ongoing and future conflicts with Iran and its proxies push some states into hardening their opposition and imposing a two-state "solution."

The current MOU with Iran cannot last. **The situation will soon become so heavy that the world will be clamoring for a master mediator better than the current dealmaker, Donald Trump.** It is likely that the next one will be the Antichrist, the ultimate dealmaker.

Even with his unprecedented level of presidential power, Trump's quest to win the prize of ultimate peacemaker for the Middle East has failed. The one who's used to winning, but does not know God, cannot win with the devil.

We should watch with discernment for how these developments set the stage for many important end-time events.

A Series of Accords, but No Peace

Other notable accords also attempted to persuade Israel's Muslim neighbors to stop murdering Jews in their relentless pursuit of wiping Israel off the map — all were brokered by the US:

- **The Camp David Accords (1978) and Egypt-Israel Peace Treaty (1979)** — Brokered by President Carter at Camp David, these talks led Egypt to recognize Israel and Israel to withdraw from the Sinai, ending a formal state of war between them.

The interfaith coalition is more than convenient to the evolving political system; it is essential.

The Abrahamic Family House sets the stage for all faiths that claim to originate with Abraham to worship as one, while unfaithful to the God of the Bible and His Son, Jesus Christ (Rev. 17).

The Quran and centuries of evidence show that Islam doesn't tolerate co-existence with any other religion but forces conformity. That must change to realize "world peace."

At the midpoint of the Antichrist's seven-year covenant, he will destroy the universal harlot church and demand that all people worship only him or pay with their lives (Rev. 13). Roman Catholics along with Eastern Orthodox and some Evangelical Protestants have already shown a united front for interfaith ecumenism.

Know the scriptures. If you're antisemitic, you are in agreement with the spirit of antichrist.

- **The Oslo Accords (1993–1995)** — These agreements created mutual recognition between Israel and the PLO and set up the Palestinian Authority, in pursuit of a gradual path to a final peace agreement.
- **Israel-Jordan Peace Treaty (Wadi Araba, 1994)** — This treaty normalized relations between Israel and Jordan, resolving several bilateral disputes, again held up as a building block for wider regional peace.

In 2000, President Bill Clinton hosted Israeli Prime Minister Ehud Barak and Palestinian leader Yasser Arafat at Camp David for intensive final-status talks in an attempt to save the fledgling Oslo Accords, but it ended with no agreement and ultimately failed.

Wars, Jihadist-martyrs, deceptive tactics, hatred, and rejection of Israel's right to exist have not slowed down. Satan will never stop his relentless war with Israel or Christians until Jesus stops him.

Those who claim that Israel today is not ethnic Israel, and therefore not due a biblical promise of redemption, cannot give answers for the dozens of prophetic passages already precisely filled, and that are being fulfilled in favor of today's Israel.

Do not be fooled, Christian. God's calling and promise to Israel cannot be broken or fulfilled by Gentiles.

Teaching the church at Rome about Israel in the end-times, Paul wrote:

"I say then, has God cast away His people? Certainly not! God has not cast away His people whom He foreknew. Have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation has come to the Gentiles. And so all Israel will be saved. For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable."

(Romans 11:1, 2, 11, 26, 29).

Photo ops, pen and ink, smiles, handshakes, and exchanging accolades cannot extinguish Islamic hatred for Israel that God has put in their very souls.

Uniquely End-Time

In early 2020, the White House released a plan that emphasized economic development, regional cooperation, a new political alignment, and interfaith tolerance as the pathway to peace in the Middle East. Trump's son-in-law, Jared Kushner, an Orthodox Jew, and Trump's long-time friend, Steve Witkoff, were head architects for the Accords.

It is unique to previous agreements:

- It is happening very late in the life of a single generation since the rebirth of Israel in 1948. Israel is the main end-times timetable for the world (Matt. 24:33-34).
- It came on the heels of President Trump's designating Jerusalem as the capital of Israel in 2017.
- It only includes nations that do not share a border with Israel and are not at war with Israel either. In prior treaties war and shared borders were integral factors.
- It was followed by Trump's Board of Peace in 2026, with clear ties between the two focused on peace between *Jews* and *Muslims*.

Only the Beginning

The Abraham Accords has appeared somewhat harmless to this point, and trade between the signing parties has increased. I believe President Trump hoped that momentum would build convincing more important Muslim countries to come aboard shortly after the original signing, such as Saudi Arabia, or Turkey, but they are holding out for a two-state commitment.

He has ask countries outside the Middle East to join also, but was met with strong resistance, since a two-state solution is not part of the deal (yet).

The countries that *have* joined, required special concessions and/or arms deals with America.

In 2020, Trump still didn't understand the depth of internal hatred Muslims have toward Jews. With this new MOU with Iran, it appears that he still doesn't understand.

This is a dark day for Israel, for America, and for the world!

The Abraham Accords, though relatively insignificant at this point, cer-

Opposing views about who Abraham's promised seed is goes back to his first two sons, Ishmael and Isaac.

Christians and Jews affirm the biblical account showing Isaac, born of miracle birth, as the spiritual seed of promise — not Ishmael, who, though he was the firstborn, was of natural birth through Sarai's maidservant, Hagar (Genesis 16:1: 17:18-21).

Muslims, self-identifying haters of Christians and Jews, contend that Ishmael is the spiritual seed of promise, not Isaac, since Ishmael was the firstborn son—and more than that, they claim their prophet, Muhammad, is of the lineage of Ishmael, even though no historical record supports that.

Together, this most unusual trifecta, the Abraham Accords, the Board of Peace, and the MOU with Iran, could lead straight to a two-state agreement, the revealing of the Antichrist, and the Great Tribulation!

tainly appears to be the seed of what will soon become Daniel’s “covenant with many” (Daniel 9:27)!

The Board of Peace

- The Board of Peace was an attempt to take advantage of a little momentum for peace between Israel and Hamas at the time by quickly promoting a rebirth and rebuild for Gaza. Naturally, many more countries signed on to favor Gaza than those who did The Abraham Accords to favor Israel; twenty-six signed on, to be exact.

Under President Trump, a short document, composed of diplomatic statements only, focused on rebuilding Gaza—something relatively easy and noncommittal. By signing on, national leaders appeared to be team players for peace and prosperity, and they gained favor with Trump. Who wouldn’t want that? Also, joining early likely gave them an opening for a piece of the pie in what was termed “the master plan” for the “New Gaza.”

- Unlike the Abraham Accords, it is made up of countries across the globe, East to West.
- As of today, it appears dormant, its bank account empty. But the spirit behind it is very much alive.

Some have made grand commitments, but no one has put up any money.

At some point in the near future, ten nations will come together and dominate the world. Daniel describes them as an unlikely mix: the remnants of the Roman Empire joining weaker nations to form a surreal coalition. The Board of Peace certainly has the makings for such an agreement. I have believed for many years that the ten toes, representing the last world kingdom before the return of our Lord, represent the West and the East together, including Islam (Dan. 2:42-43). As Daniel said, they join, but they do not adhere to one another.

The Abraham Accords was designed to bring peace to the region, and the Board of Peace to bring prosperity.

Outside the framework of the coming ten-nation coalition will rise what Daniel describes as “a little horn,” who is the Antichrist identified by the Apostle John. Daniel also says that he will make “a covenant with many” (Dan. 7:8, 20-26; 9:27; I John 2:18).

The ten toes in Daniel 2, and the ten kings in Daniel 7, are the same ten-nation ruling coalition.

THE USA WILL NO LONGER BE THE STAND-ALONE SUPERPOWER!

“The curses on the Jews were brought to pass literally—so also will be the blessings. The scattering was literal—so also will be the gathering. The pulling down of Zion was literal—so also will be the building up. The rejection of Israel was literal—so also will be the restoration.”

J. C. Ryle (1867) is still a respected Bible scholar today.

“Little children, it is the last hour; and as you have heard that the Antichrist is coming...” (I Jn. 2:18).

“Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week; but in the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate” (Daniel 9:27).

Israel and Jerusalem Are Ground Zero for the Whole World!

From a biblical worldview, it is striking yet unsurprising that Israel and Jerusalem are the center of global attention. Modern Israel was re-established in 1948, and within a single lifetime it has become a constant source of wars, terror, and diplomatic crises, far out of proportion to its size. I count at least seven Old Testament prophets through whom God spoke to us about Israel’s suffering and trouble for the world in the end of this age.

Zechariah and Ezekiel say:

- Zechariah speaks of all nations gathered against Jerusalem in the

end, when the Lord Himself will defend His people:

“Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of drunkenness to all the surrounding peoples... And it shall happen in that day that I will make Jerusalem a very heavy stone for all peoples” (Zech. 12:2-3).

- Ezekiel describes a time when many nations will come against Israel, drawn by God’s own hand to final victory (Ezek. 38-39).

New national coalitions happen fast in the end times. We should watch for this to form soon.

Biblical end times show things changing suddenly.

Most countries outside the Middle East largely ignored modern Israel until now, when the crisis in the Strait of Hormuz turned Israel into a global problem overnight.

Watch for many more “suddenlies” to come.

Suddenly, Israel is the World’s Big Problem

Most countries outside the Middle East ignored Israel until now when, within only five days after the war with Iran began, Iran began to target merchant ships in the Strait of Hormuz and, within a few short weeks, took complete control, freezing passage for ships from as many as 100 countries represented by up to 3000 ships which have been stuck in the Strait of Hor-

muz. Who would have thought that would be the catalyst for driving the world against Israel?

The increasing focus on Israel in world affairs, and the repeated attempts to solve “the Israel problem” through political accords, harmonize with the Bible’s prophetic picture, even though no accord has ever led to a fulfillment. We are drawing ever-so-close to seeing things prophesied 2600 years ago!

“And it will come to pass at the same time, when Gog comes against the land of Israel,” says the Lord GOD, “that My fury will show in My face (Ezekiel 38:13)!

Israel’s very existence and centrality in world affairs two thousand years after its destruction should be a miracle reminder that God’s promises to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and affirmed by the Apostle Paul, still stand.

“Has God cast away His people? Certainly not!... God has not cast away His people whom He foreknew” (Romans 11:1-2).

Virtually, the entire world of 195 nations has suddenly found itself arguing over and negotiating for their own well-being around tiny Israel!

The Anti-Defamation League tracked over 6,000 antisemitic incidents, five times more than only a decade ago, and estimates that 46% of the world’s population is antisemitic, and growing.

According to Pew Research, in the mid-2010s roughly 60% of Americans sympathized with Israel, vs. under 20% with Palestinians. By 2025-2026, only about 36-46% side more with Israel, with 33-41% siding with Palestinians, and majorities either took neither side or held unfavorable views of Israel.

God is clearly proving His Word to be true, and that includes His promise to Israel. He is still the God of Israel, ordering the affairs of kings who, little known to them, are playing right into God’s plan!

President Trump has, on multiple occasions, said that Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu of Israel “will do whatever I want him to do.”

In reality, President Trump does whatever God tells him to do regard-

ing Israel. Nothing originates with him on that front, but rather with "the Lord, the Holy one of Israel" (Ezek. 39:7).

Know the God of the Bible and Have Peace.

God's Word teaches and illustrates that the world's peace can come only by reconciliation with Him, something already accomplished by living faith in His Son and our Savior, Jesus Christ.

We all, Jew and Gentile, can become that "one new man" the Apostle Paul identifies in his letter to the Ephesians, only after each one, Jew and Gentile, has believed on the Savior.

"For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace..." (Ephesians 2:14-15)

To seek for peace is admirable and scriptural (Hebrews 12:14). It should be a priority for world leaders, but even the United States cannot bring about world peace in the end. President Trump cannot. Israel cannot. False prophets surely cannot do it, and no true prophet would even try. No coalition of nations can do it, and the coming Antichrist will bring a temporary sense of peace only because it's part of his assignment in God's end-time plan. For one small moment in time, God will let him imitate the true Messiah.

God has reserved *real* peace through His Son when He returns as King of kings, Lord of lords, and the Prince of Peace (Rev. 11-21; Isaiah 9:6).

Spiritual Considerations

A False or Temporary Peace

When the first seal is opened in Revelation, John writes:

"Now I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals... And I looked, and behold, a white horse. He who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer" (Rev. 6:1-2).

This is a picture of conquering by deception and coercion first, then force.

The Enemy comes at all people in three ways:

1. Deception to lure us.
2. Coercion to strain us.
3. Force to overwhelm us.

Each one of these is a test of faith for the Christian.

After deception comes coercion, which is already in play in many places around the world, including the UK, which was formerly Christian. Peer pressure to follow the status quo is everywhere, here in the USA too. People have a herd mentality by nature. It feeds itself. **And it's going to grow worse, much worse. Prepare now!**

Hiding our heads in the sand will not stop it or even slow it down. That is not the way the Lord would

have us respond. We must respond through prayer and through assembling together with like-minded believers now. We must seek His face and ask Him to show us, through His Word and by His Spirit, how to be made ready for His coming. He's waiting.

Isaiah 13 is part of a broader prophetic theme. The concept of cosmic signs and the "Day of the Lord" serves as a dual warning, applying both to the fall of historical Babylon, as well as to the modern Babylon in which we live today. **It points to the return of Jesus Christ and His final judgment of worldly systems in opposition to God, exactly where we find ourselves today.**

The Prophet Ezekiel says:

"Because, indeed, because they have seduced My people, saying, 'Peace!' when there is no peace—and one builds a wall, and they plaster it with untempered mortar—say to those who plaster it with untempered mortar, that it will fall. There will be flooding rain, and you, O great hailstones, shall fall; and a stormy wind shall tear it down" (Ezekiel 13:10-11).

Deception is at an all-time high.

Everything that looks good is not good.

Everything that sounds good is not good.

Everything that feels good is not good.

Don't follow the lost masses, who have either never known the Truth, or have rejected Him.

What about the rapture?

While all followers of Jesus Christ should be looking with great anticipation toward His soon return, the Bible indicates that we will see a lot of action before He appears.

Notice how plainly the Apostle Paul states that in his letter to Thessalonica:

"Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God" (II Thess. 2:3-4).

In short order, the Antichrist himself will force himself upon the world, controlling the economic, political, and religious systems. Then, it will be too late. **Will the Church of today be here then? The Bible indicates we could be.**

Many Christians will be here, obviously, since both Daniel and John prophesy that he will be given power over followers of Jesus Christ — a time known as "the perseverance of the saints" (Dan. 7:25; Rev. 13:7-10).

Any promise of a "golden age" that is not describing the righteous reign of our Lord Jesus Christ is a lie.

If we are preparing ourselves glorious for meeting Jesus, we'll be ready to stand if we're here. The same God who saved us will sustain us if need be.

Israel Under Judgment

"You will say, 'I will go up against a land of unwalled villages; I will go to a peaceful people, who dwell safely, all of them dwelling without walls, and having neither bars nor gates'" (Ezekiel 38:11).

Interpretations differ on timing, but the picture is clear: there will be a season when Israel enjoys a sense of security, then suddenly, the Enemy will strike (Ezek. 38:18 - 39:8).

The Oct. 7, 2023, surprise is a type of what lies ahead; but the difference next time will be that God will deliver, not man.

Consider what was happening when Hamas successfully invaded in 2023:

- The immediate group of Israelis who were pillaged and slaughtered were having their annual feast of idolatry and debauchery.
- While the Golan Heights is separated by a high concrete wall, the villages near Gaza were separated only by a cyclone fence — a sense of security indeed!

Consider what continues unabated:

- Tel-Aviv is widely known to be a center for prostitution in the Middle East region.
- It proudly claims to be "the gateway for the LGBTQ+ community" in the Middle East (and one of the foremost centers in the world).
- Historically, Tel Aviv has been described as the center of the sex trade in the Middle East.

When God partially blinded Israel so that they could not see their Savior until He comes again, He did not also excuse them for living in sin and debauchery. They still have "the Law and the Prophets," "the oracles of God" (Rom. 2:1-11; 9:1-5).

Normalization, shared defense arrangements, and economic integration can contribute to a greater feeling of safety in Israel, but God said that Israel is due more judgment, including His "refiner's fire" (Mal. 3:1-6).

Throughout the Old Testament, God used Israel's enemies to judge her, to discipline her, and to refine His work in her. He is doing the same today.

The dispersion and destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple (between 66 to 70 AD), the Holocaust (between 1944 and 1945), and the October 7, 2023, Hamas invasion are examples. God has made Iran and its proxies openly hostile toward Israel. Increasing antisemitism worldwide is adding to the Iranian hostility that God is us-

ing too, both as part of Israel's present-day penalty for rejecting His Son and as a catalyst to isolate Israel, when only He can deliver them.

Remember, the greatest wars that the world will ever see are still to come, so any peace agreement is temporary.

"When He opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, 'Come and see.' Another horse, fiery red, went out. And it was granted to the one who sat on it to take peace from the earth, and that people should kill one another; and there was given to him a great sword" (Rev. 6:3-4).

I pray that God will open the spiritual eyes as well as for many Gentiles who do claim to believe on His Son.

Severe testing will not be exclusive to Israel, but also the Church will be tested. Many will fail those tests and fall in line with the Harlot. Those will be the persecutors of the Bride (Rev. 17:5-6)

"On her forehead a name was written: MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

I saw the woman, drunk with the blood of the saints and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus. And when I saw her, I marveled with great amazement."

Watch and Pray

As followers of Jesus Christ, we are not called to fatalism or passivity, but to vigilance and faithfulness. As end-time world events accelerate, Christians must read the times through the lens of scripture, not the lens of the spirit of this world — the headlines. We don't live in the 1950s anymore.

About these days our Lord said:

"But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectedly... Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things... and to stand before the Son of Man" (Luke 21:34-36).

We should guard our hearts and minds, manage our associations, stay spiritually awake, and pursue becoming spotless, "a chaste virgin" for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (II Cor. 11:2).
